- Provision of an efficient service to satisfy the needs of the public.

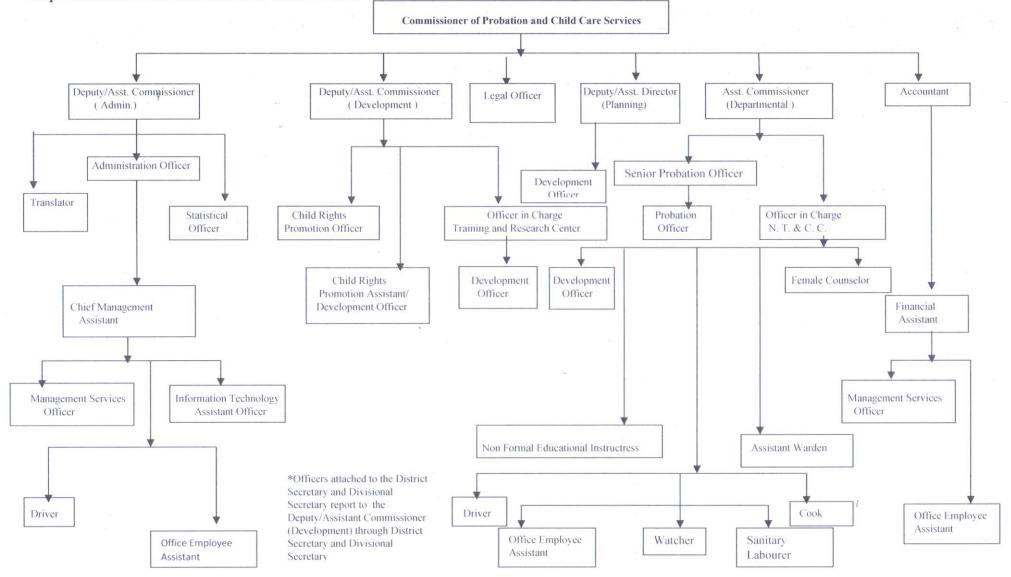
